

ALL IS CALM AUDITIONS

All Is Calm can be performed by any number of singers and actors. In the original production there were three actors and nine singers. There are 39 characters in the script. Various dialects are a vital part of the musicality and the storytelling.

The music of the show is a wide selection of material, including 30-plus songs ranging from Celtic ballads to iconic World War I songs, and Christmas carols from the participating countries. The work was created for a male chorus. An all-male sound and performing the piece a cappella are essential to the honesty of the work.

Actors auditioning will be asked to sing one of these songs (pick one): “O Come, O Come Emmanuel”, The First Noel”. “Silent Night”. Actors will also be asked to do a cold reading from the script.
